A CALL TO CONSECRATION

As Fresh Oil enters a new season, these seven days are an intentional time to set ourselves apart, discipline our appetites, seek God together, and align ourselves with what He desires to do next.

This consecration is not simply about what we give up; it is about what we make room for. We are making room for God's presence, God's wisdom, God's provision, God's order, and God's power.

Together, we will pray specifically for the financial prosperity and provision of Fresh Oil, unity among leadership, salvation of souls, deeper commitment, spiritual growth, and clear vision for the next season.

"Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you." — James 4:8

FASTING WINDOW

Each day, September 13-19, we will fast from 4:00 PM until 10:00 PM.

DAILY CONSECRATION RHYTHM

- Begin each day with prayer and the assigned Scripture readings.
- Set aside intentional time to worship, listen, and journal what God is speaking.
- Limit distractions that compete with spiritual focus.
- Pray not only for personal needs, but for Fresh Oil and the corporate assignment.
- End each day by reviewing the application and praying the written prayer in agreement.

Fasting should be practiced with wisdom. Individuals should choose an appropriate fast according to their circumstances and responsibilities. The spiritual objective is consecration, prayer, and disciplined focus on God.

DAY 1 | SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 13

FASTING HOURS: 4:00 PM - 10:00 PM

CONSECRATE THE HOUSE

Lord, Start With Us.

SCRIPTURE READINGS

Joshua 3:1-5; Romans 12:1-2; Psalm 51:10-12

“Sanctify yourselves: for to morrow the LORD will do wonders among you.” — Joshua 3:5

Joshua told the people to sanctify themselves before God performed wonders among them. That order matters. We often ask God for the wonder without preparing ourselves for what the wonder will require.

Consecration says, “Before I ask God to change what is around me, I give Him permission to change what is within me.” As we begin, we are asking God to search Fresh Oil - from the pulpit to the pew - and remove anything that would hinder the next move.

PERSONAL APPLICATION

Examine your heart. Release offenses, unhealthy habits, distractions, attitudes, and anything competing with your devotion to God.

PRAYER

Father, we present ourselves to You again. Purify our motives, renew our minds, cleanse our hearts, and align our desires with Yours. Whatever cannot accompany us into the next season, give us grace to release it. Consecrate Fresh Oil from the leadership to every member. Make us vessels prepared for Your use. Do wonders among us again. In Jesus’ name, Amen.

DAY 2 | MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 14

FASTING HOURS: 4:00 PM - 10:00 PM

PROSPERITY & PROVISION FOR THE VISION

There Will Be Provision for the Assignment.

SCRIPTURE READINGS

Deuteronomy 8:18; Philippians 4:19; 2 Corinthians 9:6-11; Malachi 3:10-12

“But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth...”
— Deuteronomy 8:18

We are not merely praying for money; we are praying for Kingdom resources. God gives power to produce wealth, and He provides seed to the sower so that resources can become instruments of generosity and ministry.

Our prayer is: Lord, finance what You have assigned Fresh Oil to accomplish. We believe for increased giving, wise stewardship, new resources, business growth, career advancement, opportunities, generous partners, and supernatural provision. Prosperity must always have purpose.

PERSONAL APPLICATION

Pray over your personal finances and Fresh Oil's finances. Ask God for increase, but also for wisdom, discipline, generosity, integrity, and stewardship.

PRAYER

Father, You are our Source. Prosper the work You have entrusted to Fresh Oil. Bless our members, businesses, careers, entrepreneurs, families, and ministry partners. Open legitimate doors of opportunity and increase our capacity to give. Let there always be seed to sow, bread to eat, and provision for the vision. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 3 | TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 15

FASTING HOURS: 4:00 PM - 10:00 PM

UNITY OF LEADERSHIP

One Vision. One Voice. One Victory.

SCRIPTURE READINGS

Psalm 133; Ephesians 4:1-6; Philippians 2:1-5; Nehemiah 4:6

“Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!” — Psalm 133:1

Psalm 133 reveals that there is a blessing God commands where unity is protected. Unity does not mean identical personalities or opinions; it means that our individual preferences are submitted to a common Kingdom purpose.

We are praying against competition, division, jealousy, offense, gossip, misunderstanding, territorialism, and personal agendas. Fresh Oil does not need everyone trying to be the head; we need everyone committed to building the house.

PERSONAL APPLICATION

Leadership should ask: Am I contributing to the unity of the house, or merely protecting my area? Choose honor, communication, and collaboration.

PRAYER

Father, make us one. Guard the relationships of every pastor, minister, leader, director, servant, and volunteer. Remove pride, competition, offense, and hidden agendas. Teach us to communicate with maturity, honor one another, and protect the vision You have given this house. Give Fresh Oil one heart for Your glory. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 4 | WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 16

FASTING HOURS: 4:00 PM - 10:00 PM

SOULS, SALVATION & EVANGELISM

Fill the House!

SCRIPTURE READINGS

Luke 14:15-23; Acts 2:37-47; Romans 10:9-15; Matthew 28:18-20

“Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled.”

— Luke 14:23

Church growth cannot simply mean more people transferring from somebody else’s church. We need souls - people who do not know Jesus, families needing restoration, young people searching for identity, and people who have given up on church.

Our prayer is not merely, “Lord, send people.” It is also, “Lord, make us ready to receive the people You send.” We want a house prepared to disciple, love, teach, restore, and serve.

PERSONAL APPLICATION

Identify at least three people who need Christ or need to reconnect with a church community. Pray for them specifically and look for an opportunity to invite or encourage them.

PRAYER

Father, give Fresh Oil a burden for souls. Let salvation break out in our services. Draw sons, daughters, families, young adults, children, and entire households to Christ. Give us courage to evangelize beyond our walls. Fill Your house - not merely with crowds, but with changed lives. In Jesus’ name, Amen.

DAY 5 | THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 17

FASTING HOURS: 4:00 PM - 10:00 PM

COMMITMENT & OWNERSHIP

From Attenders to Stakeholders.

SCRIPTURE READINGS

Nehemiah 2:17-20; Nehemiah 4:6; 1 Corinthians 15:58; Colossians 3:23-24

“So built we the wall... for the people had a mind to work.” — Nehemiah 4:6

The wall was not rebuilt merely because Nehemiah had a vision. The wall was rebuilt because the people embraced the vision. There is a difference between attendance and ownership.

Attenders ask, “What is the church doing?” Stakeholders ask, “What can I do to help us accomplish it?” The next season of Fresh Oil cannot rest on a handful of faithful people carrying everything. Everybody has a piece of the wall.

PERSONAL APPLICATION

Ask: Where can my time, talent, spiritual gift, resources, and consistency strengthen Fresh Oil?
Commit to one area where you will become more dependable.

PRAYER

Father, deliver us from inconsistency and complacency. Give us a mind to work. Raise dependable servants who serve from love rather than recognition. Help us understand that ministry belongs to all of us. Make us stakeholders in the vision. In Jesus’ name, Amen.

FASTING HOURS: 4:00 PM - 10:00 PM

FRESH OIL & SPIRITUAL POWER

Don't Let Us Have Church Without You.

SCRIPTURE READINGS

Zechariah 4:6; Acts 1:8; Acts 2:1-4; Psalm 92:10; Ephesians 5:18

“Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts.” — Zechariah 4:6

We can have excellent music, organized ministries, beautiful presentation, strong administration, and polished services - and still desperately need the presence of God.

Fresh Oil must never become merely our name. Fresh oil must remain our experience. We are asking God for renewed anointing upon preaching, teaching, worship, prayer, altar ministry, leadership, outreach, children, youth, young adults, families, and every ministry of the house.

PERSONAL APPLICATION

Spend additional personal time in worship today without asking God for anything. Simply pursue His presence and listen.

PRAYER

Holy Spirit, breathe upon Fresh Oil again. We do not want to operate from yesterday's oil. Give us fresh revelation, fresh passion, fresh worship, fresh power, and fresh sensitivity to Your voice. Let chains be broken, burdens lifted, minds renewed, and lives transformed whenever we gather. In Jesus' name, Amen.

FASTING HOURS: 4:00 PM - 10:00 PM

SCRIPTURE READINGS

Isaiah 54:2-3; Habakkuk 2:2-3; Ephesians 3:20-21; Philippians 3:13-14

“Enlarge the place of thy tent... lengthen thy cords, and strengthen thy stakes.” — Isaiah 54:2

Before expansion occurs, preparation for expansion is commanded. God tells His people to make room before they see what He is sending. That is faith.

As Fresh Oil moves beyond five years, we are not simply asking God to make the church bigger. We are asking Him to make us stronger, healthier, deeper, wiser, and more effective. Growth without strengthened stakes can become a burden rather than a blessing.

PERSONAL APPLICATION
